A TALK ON INSTRUMENTAL QUEEN INSEMINATION BY MICHAEL COLLIER

ON FRIDAY 18TH JANUARY 2019 AT SHERBORNE ST. JOHN VILLAGE HALL

We are delighted to announce that Michael Collier, a commercial beekeeper from Cornbrooke Bee Farm in Ludlow, Shropshire, will be coming to Basingstoke on Friday 18th January 2019 to talk about instrumental insemination of honey bee queens.



Michael is the UK's leading authority on Honey Bee Instrumental Insemination and runs training courses from his Shropshire apiary and elsewhere using a mobile laboratory. Michael trained extensively in Germany with Dr Fischer and in the USA with Sue Cobey over many years and has worked with many of the UK's leading Universities.

He will be running a workshop on "Instrumental Insemination" at the BBKA Spring Convention next April at Harper Adams University.

We are anticipating a high level of interest in this talk, which any Beekeeper studying for BBKA Module 7 will find particularly relevant. The seating capacity of the hall is 120, so we have decided to make this a "Ticket Only" evening, with an Online Form to request tickets. This form can be found at


